The vision for the Cain Center for the Arts began to come into view in 2019 with the approval of new schematic designs for the Cornelius complex in September and a \$500,000 financial commitment in November from the Cashion family, owners of four Cashion Food Mart stores in Huntersville and Cornelius. The nonprofit Cain Center

for the Arts was established in 2017 and is in the midst of a \$25 million campaign to fund construction of the center, which will be built on Catawba Avenue, across from town hall. The center will be named for Bill and Ericka Cain, who donated \$5 million to the project. □
