Now that the drawings are finalized, Cain Center will be working with the town to schedule the demolition of the existing buildings on the venue's future site. When complete, Cain Center for the Arts will include a 400-seat theater, gallery space, event spaces, three classrooms, a community green space and an outdoor plaza. As the region's only public arts and community center, it will offer performances, education experiences, and a place for community events and gatherings.
