Financial:

- 1. As of the end of last month (10/31) we were 87% complete (\$1,396,172 for October, with \$2,641,218 remaining)
- 2. As of the end of this month (11/30/22) we project to be 96% complete (\$1,586,305 for November.
- 3. Remaining projected payments:
 - a. December \$534,000
 - b. January \$197,000
 - c. February \$52,000
 - d. Otherwise, TBD (very minor)
- 4. Tax credit info already requested to assist our accountant with necessary submissions.

Exterior

- 1. Digital marquis sign is up and running!
- 2. Roof soffit trim has been installed.
- 3. Irrigation ongoing, to be completed this week.
- 4. Site asphalt this Friday
- 5. Landscaping and sod next week
- 6. Exterior pavers starting tomorrow
- 7. Remaining curbing over the next 2 weeks
- 8. Overall, all exterior work should be completed by Thanksgiving, except for minor items delayed by bad/wet weather.
- We have decided not to spend money on creating another parking area on Gordon Cashion's land. We received information from the Town that allows Cain necessary parking without improving Gordon's parcel.
- 10. Justin's team finalizing a parking plan.
- 11. Positive activity expected soon on clearing the barricaded sidewalk next door.
- 12. Town paving to be done after Thanksgiving.

<u>Interior</u>

- 1. Finishes are moving rapidly in all areas.
- 2. Cabinetry is being installed in all areas.
- 3. Theater seating being installed, about 50% complete now.
- 4. Decorative stair handrail being installed.
- 5. Chandelier being delivered today. Installation within a few days (need more cleaning first).
- 6. Fire pump wiring being completed, as needed for testing.
- 7. All work is progressing on TCO-required issues.

- 8. Card access, security cameras finishing up.
- 9. WIFI and phones finishing up.
- 10. Finishes ongoing in the theater (carpet, linoleum, metal trim).
- 11. Stage projector screen to be installed in the next few days.

Inspections/Approvals/Move-in/Commissioning

- 1. Ongoing inspections have been positive.
- 2. Going for TCO the week after Thanksgiving (by Dec 1st). Expect success.
- 3. Furniture installation currently scheduled for week of Dec 5th. May float a few days.
- 4. ABC license will be requested after TCO approval.
- 5. 12/14 12/15 commissioning of the theater (drapes, lighting).
- 6. 12/19 commissioning of acoustics
- 7. 12/26 commissioning of audio/video
- 8. Final cleaning and remaining work issues throughout December.
- 9. Public Opening Jan 3rd.
